- Founded in 1997 by RSNA and HIMSS
- Develops and publishes standards-based implementation guides, called IHE Profiles
- Holds annual IHE Connectathons for specification testing

*In 2024, **IHE** has celebrated its 25th anniversary of providing testing and implementation services around the globe.*

*In 2026, **IHE-Europe** will celebrate the 25th edition of the **IHE-Europe Connectathon**.*



Vision

To enable seamless and secure access to information whenever and wherever it is needed

Mission

To improve healthcare by providing specifications, tools and services for interoperability

WHAT IS IT

an international event where companies that develop healthcare systems and products (vendors) can test the interoperability and compliance of their products against IHE specifications, in a collaborative and supervised environment.

OBJECTIVE

to ensure that healthcare information systems can communicate effectively with each other, improving the speed and ease of deployment, ultimately driving efficiency and quality of patient care.

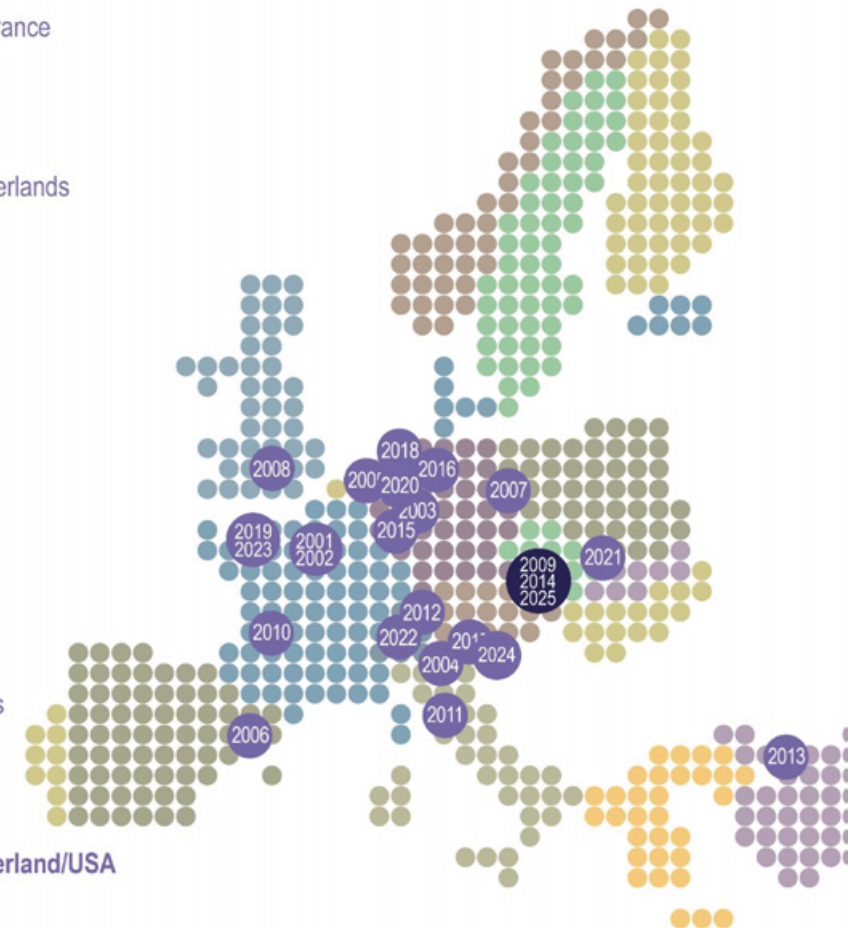
only products developed with systems tested during the Connectathon can benefit from the IHE Connectathon SEAL

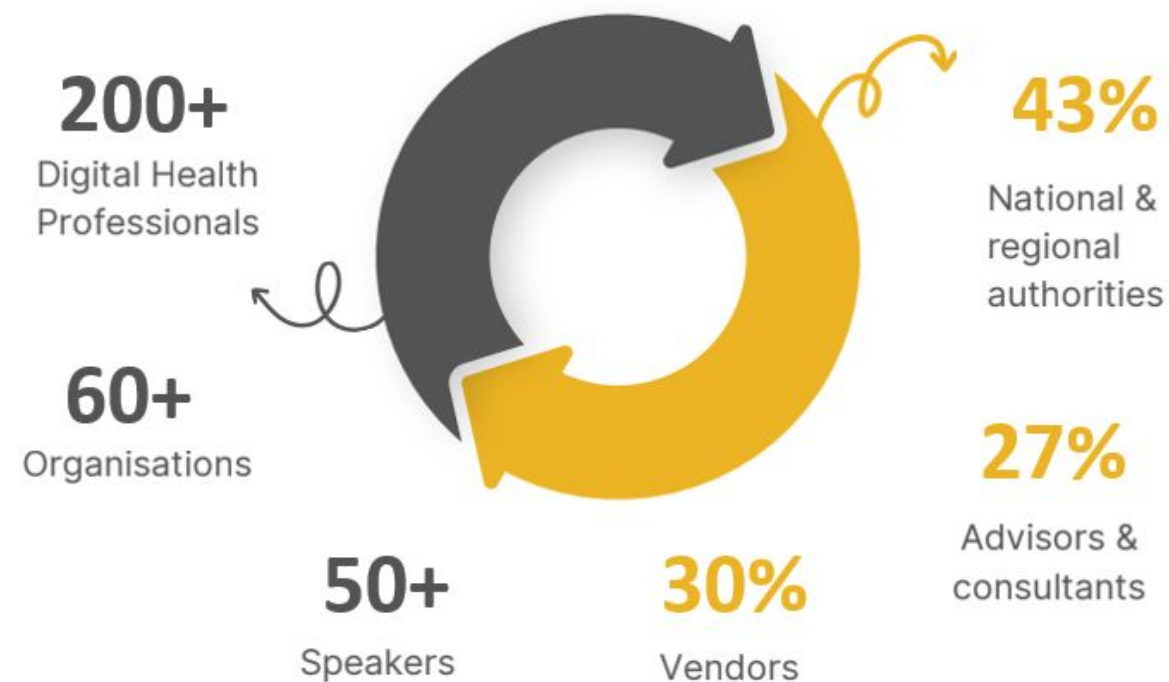


The **IHE Connectathon Week** represents a **broader value proposition**, encompassing not only the activity on the floor but also the **several side events and delegations**.

An IHE Plugathon is smaller and more agile than a IHE Connectathon, with a particular focus on prototypes and emerging standards.

It is designed for **early-stage testing and learning**, offering participants a safe environment to identify and resolve issues **without the pressure of official certification**.

At the same time, **it helps teams prepare their systems for the formal IHE Connectathon**, ensuring they are ready for more advanced and large-scale interoperability testing.
