What is digital pathology actually?

"Process of digitising the histological sections and their digital assessment / examination"

4 categories:

- IT-equipment (e.g. digital slide-scanners, bandwidth, etc.)
- Integration of the IT-equipment into hospital systems
- Digital workflow digital pathology needs a holistic view on the topic
- Artificial intelligence (Add-On)



HEAL NOW

- first cross-border project in health between AT & HU
- Lasted from 2020 2022 incl. a budget of approx. 580.000€ (85% ERDF)
- Main results:
 - Strategic plan "Cooperation Agenda 2030"
 - Initiation of the bilateral rescue treaty
 - Hospital cooperation in the field of digital pathology
- → 2 digital slide scanners for research purpose for the hospital of Wr. Neustadt collaboration between Sopron and Wr. Neustadt started







PathoCon



- Lasting from October 2024 March 2026, including a budget of approx. 188.000€ (80% ERDF)
- Establishing of an institutional cooperation in the field of digital pathology between Lower Austria and Hungary

Expected output: signing of a bilateral cooperation agreement, including:

- Legal and regulatory aspects
- Financial aspects
- Technical aspects
- Data protection aspects





DIGI-PAT

"Structural reform of organizational and process models in digital pathology for person-centered and holistic cancer care"

- → Shaping a path towards digital pathology throughout Lower Austria
- Duration: November 2023 November 2025
- Budget: € 450,000 (100% financed from European funds)
- EU program: Technical support instrument (TSI)

External experts / partners:

- European Commission, DG REFORM
- Maastricht University Medical Centre





DIGI-PAT

- Analysis of current pathological (internal & external) workflows and processes
 - Development of a **digital process model** for the most efficient working processes possible in the future including train-the-trainer activities
 - Development of a **roadmap** for the gradual implementation of digital pathology throughout Lower Austria
 - Support in the preparation of tender documents
- → Standardised PMIS was implemented in parallel






Outlook for the coming years

<u>Implementation is unavoidable:</u>

- Higher quality
- Faster diagnosis
- Remote access
- Enhanced education
- Al integration



<u>But...:</u>

- High initial costs (Hardware, Software, etc.)
- Data management
- Integration / interoperability
- Workflow disruption
- Technical challenges (image quality, etc.)
